


George's Kibitzeria

George's Kibitzeria, an offshoot of George's Spaghetti House, managed by Howard Matthews, opened at 338 Huron St. (NW corner Huron and Harbord) on Jan 17, 1966. Jazz was offered weekends in a restaurant aimed mainly at the university students, featuring "moderate lunch and supper prices".

It appears to have survived until some time after May 1969 and before May 1970 by which time a new restaurant appeared on that site. *Meat and Potatoes* appears in Globe and Mail articles into the mid-1970s also supporting live music. Publicity tailed off dramatically in the later years.

Data Collection

These listings are a composite of what appeared in the Toronto Telegram's (the Tely) What's Going On listing in the Showcase Section and the Chum About Town listings in the After Four Sections and classifieds, augmented by electronic searches of the Toronto Star (Star), Globe and Mail (G&M) and the University of Toronto newspaper archives of The Varsity from the 1960s on. Where I take words directly from a listing I use "quotation marks" and/or italics. Where I cite an article I reference the reporter if identified, as best I can.
